**RE: WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT TITLE 1 PROGRAM YEAR 2004 RESCISSION**

**PURPOSE:** To announce the contract revisions to the Workforce Development Boards (WDB) due to the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) rescission to Wisconsin for Program Year (PY) 2004.

**BACKGROUND:** The United States Department of Labor (reference Federal Register Part III, March 25, 2005 and TEGL 34-04 dated May 19, 2005) announced a rescission to the WIA Adult and Dislocated Workers Programs. There is no reduction in the WIA Youth program. For Wisconsin, the rescission amount totaled \$196,430, of which \$79,661 was on the WIA Adult Program and \$116,769 was on the WIA Dislocated Worker Program.

The allocation of the rescission results in the following:

The State Administration and Statewide Projects reduce funding at the state level. The Rapid Response reduction will be taken against the unexpended contract balances on June 30, 2005. The local program and local administrative reductions are being applied to local 2004 contracts.

Attached is a chart detailing the contract changes for each WDB for the WIA Adult, WIA Dislocated Worker and WIA Local Administration grants.

The Department issued contract addendums that reflect the attached allocations to Workforce Development Boards.

**ACTION SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

WDBs need to adjust their accounting records to the revised contract totals.
